OVERVIEW

The primary responsibility of the Human Rights Commission (HRC) is to promote understanding and observance of human rights in the Cayman Islands. Its mission is to lead in the promotion, protection and preservation of human rights in the Cayman Islands by:

- Promoting the integration of human rights values in everyday life;
- Encouraging government accountability against national and international human rights standards;
- Embracing the Cayman Islands Bill of Rights, Freedoms and Responsibilities and the principles of democracy; and
- Empowering all persons to understand and exercise their rights.

QUALIFYING CRITERIA

To be appointed to the Commission, persons must meet the criteria set out below:

- 1. Possess a keen interest in promoting understanding and observance of human rights in the Cayman Islands.
- 2. Ability to exercise sound judgement when reviewing complaints and allegations of human rights violations in the Cayman Islands.
- 3. Be politically neutral, since appointments are made by the Governor in consultation with the Premier and Leader of the Opposition.

IMPORTANT NOTE

Public officers are ineligible to be considered for appointment due to the remit/nature of the Commission.

Members of the HRC are volunteers appointed by Her Excellency, the Governor. The duration of appointment is typically 2 to 4 years.
